VIII Edition – 2021 call

Built projects section

A new edition of the DOMUS Restoration and Conservation International Award ends after a careful analysis by the Jury of the dozens of projects received.

The award ceremony for the VIII edition of the Fassa Bortolo International Award DOMUS Restoration and Preservation will be held on 24th March at 5:00 pm (CET, Italian time) through an international webinar (with simultaneous translation in Italian, English and Portuguese).

The Prize, in its "built projects" section this year, was conceived and promoted by **Fassa S.r.l.**, owner of the "Fassa Bortolo" trademark, and by the **Department of Architecture of the University of Ferrara**, with the aim to reward architectural restoration projects that have been able to consciously interpret the conservative principles in which the scientific community recognizes itself, even by resorting to contemporary forms of expression. Due to the importance of specific entrepreneurial skills in this sector the Prize is aimed at identifying not only the designers, but also the specialized contractors that have carried out the restoration work.

The competent Jury of this edition, formed by President **Riccardo Dalla Negra** and members **Alessandra Marino**, **Jean-Pierre Pribetich** and **Franco Tomaselli**, after days of intense analysis have defined the list of winners.

The main recognition went to **Daniela Borgese**, gold medal of the edition, for the project *Restoration and enhancement of the Temple of Venus and Roma and of the Curiae Veteres in the area of the Colosseum archaeological park* (contractor: ROMA Consorzio in ATI with Restoration Workshop). The two silver medals, on the other hand, were awarded to **Carlo Luigi Ostorero**, for the *Restoration of the former Nino Colombo library in Beinasco*, Turin (contractor: Fratelli Bottano Costruzioni Edili) and to the group composed of **Martina Bonora**, **Livia Burini**, **Federica Bartalini**, **Maria Marcella Barigozzi** for the *Restoration of the façades of Palazzo Bevilacqua Costabili in Ferrara* (contractors: Spaccia srl and Coo.Be.C. Cooperativa Beni Culturali).

The Jury also wanted to assign, for particular merits and care, **five honorable mentions** (four from Italy and one from Portugal) and **highlighted six shortlisted projects** (three Spanish, two Italians and one Portuguese).

Finally, the Fassa Bortolo Special Prize, assigned to those who, in compliance with conservation principles, sustainability and architectural quality, have been able to use the solutions belonging to the Fassa Bortolo Integrated System, went to **Paolo Brambilla** and **Eugenio Castiglioni** for the restoration project of the *Petosan Mountain Refuge* near Aosta.

The awarding event will, as usual, be included in the program of the *Giornate del Restauro e del Patrimonio Culturale*, an event that reaches its fourth edition, organized by the Department of Architecture of the University of Ferrara in coordination with the XXVII edition of *Restauro - Salone Internazionale dei Beni Culturali e Ambientali*, to be held in Ferrara on June 8-10, 2022 ". This year, the fourth edition of the *Giornate del Restauro e del Patrimonio Culturale*, will see webinars and conferences dedicated to various topics on 24-25 March 2022.
